

Start



- Select the design «shelf supports or solid sheet side panel» **Combinations are only available on request.**
- Select shelf base area $W \times D$ and shelf height H
- Select colour



For regulatory and safety reasons, drawer shelves must be assembled from at least these elements.

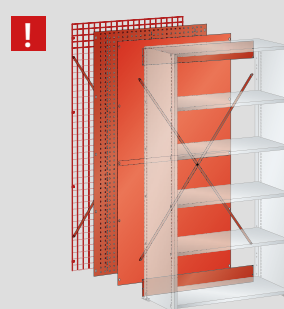
Shelf supports or solid sheet side panel



- Select shelf supports **1** or solid sheet side panel **2**
- Side panel with T chamfer for add-on shelves with back panels.
- Optional: shelf support cover, adjusting device, levelling plates, floor anchoring, side panel and partition walls and base shelf **3** to **5**
- Strictly follow planning information regarding anchoring regulations.

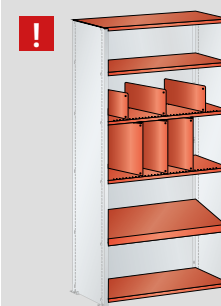
Stabilising elements



- Select stabilising elements: rear panels, horizontal bracings or rear panels **6** to **8**
- Diagonal or horizontal bracings must be used in addition to the grid rear panel for horizontal stabilisation of the shelves.
- Rear panel couplers are absolutely necessary for all rear panels in combination with shelf supports. Basic unit: $2 \times$ width 80 mm and for each add-on unit $1 \times$ width 120 mm.

Shelves



- Select shelves **9** (smooth, slotted) and shelf load
- Optional: stop bars for inclined shelf, shelf labelling, dividers and shelf dividers

Accessories



- Optional: shelf front cover strips, drawers, collection trays, clothes racks, organisational rails, see **10** to **17**

5.

Protruding parts



- Select protruding parts: hinged doors **18** or sliding doors **19**
- Cover profile on hinged doors is absolutely necessary for all hinged doors in combination with shelf supports
- Clasp lock cover, rear cover of the clasp lock for improved appearance.

Additional elements



- Optional: sideboard **20** tyre shelves **21**
